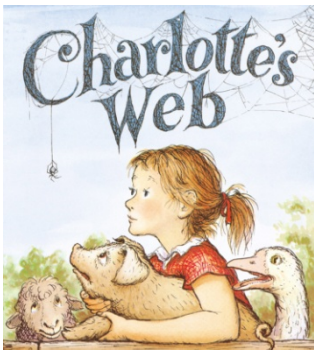


One World KidsReach invites you to bring your class to the Beautiful One World Theatre!

K-5th Grade

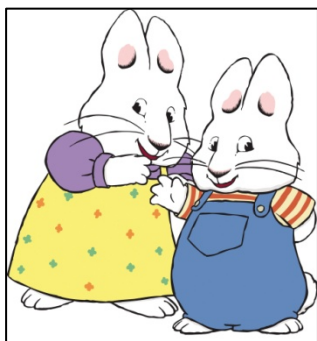
